Independence Day: The Philippine day celebration of independence varied throughout the nation's history. The earliest recorded was on April 12, 1895, when Andres Bonifacio, along with Emilio Javier, Restituto Guillermo Jacinto, Masangkay, Aurelio Tolentino, Faustino Manalak, Pedro Zabala and few other katipuneros went to Pamitinan Cave in Montalban, Rizal to initiate members of the Katipunan. Bonifacio new wrote Viva la independencia Filipina! or Long Live Philippine independence on walls of the cave to express the goal of their secret society.
