wonder if Matthew was writing to some of the newly forming Church, people who were dead set on knowing the mind of God to rid anyone who did not agree with the "right" interpretation of Scripture, liturgical practice, or stand on a particular issue. Maybe also passing a sentence judgment on people outside the church declaring them to be destined for the final furnace. Whether judgment is

focused within the church or without, it can damage God's mission. Even if we look honestly into our own hearts, is it only a field of wheat we can see? Jesus warns we simply cannot be certain who is "in" or who is "out." God's judgment may surprise us. If you can make time maybe read some more of Matthew (7:21-23; 8:11-12; 21:31-32; 25:31-46). Thank God it is not up to us, and the Angles have the weeding job, which leaves more time for us to get on with proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God.
