uestion Time at Jerusalem's Parliament. The Sadducees had been silenced, and now the Pharisees have a go at trying to trick Jesus. "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?"

"Love God and your neighbor" Jesus responds, now a question for you. "What do you think of the Messiah? Whose son is he?" They reply "The son of David." Jesus reminds them of Psalm 110 "How is it then that David by the Spirit calls him Lord, saying, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet"? "If then David calls him Lord, how is he his son?" The first of the two Lords in Psalm 110:1 is Yahweh. Then who is the second Lord in this verse? It cannot be a second god, because the Old Testament makes it clear that God is one and that there are no other gods. It cannot be David's son, because no Israelite would refer to his son as Lord. Question time is over as the Pharisees are silenced for a response and go back to bible study. Some questions do not have a black and white answer to fully explain the depths of God.
