Rather than sitting in the Sanctuary, and sometimes feeling like a Game Show Host, we sit to the sides in order to not distract the sense of God's awe. Those who lead, including the choir, lead for from what we call the 'Chancel', leaving the Sanctuary set aside for Communion upon the Holy Table or Altar. All this is a part of what we call Liturgy.

The word Liturgy means "work of the people," which means that all of us are players in the great drama that is about to unfold. Bishops, priests, deacons, and laity will lead the service, but all of us together are offering worship to God. As mentioned last Sunday, you will notice the trial seating is set up for this reason. May we enter the surprising and wonderful glory of God in worship and liturgy.
