Jesus walked all over Galilee trying to teach the people a new way of living. I wonder, whether aware or not, the crowd were in need of healing as much as deaf and mute man they presented to Jesus. They could hear and talk, and yet it seems they missed the command of Jesus to be silent. Maybe silent long enough to see beyond the miracles to the deeper way of listening to what is was God was desperately saying to them, and to us now.
