THE AUDACITY OF GENEROSITY

As I read this Sunday's gospel, I remembered the multiple meals we shared with the small communities during our recent visit to Pala-

wan. I was seized to see the poor neighbors bringing to the priests and their guests some dishes that were necessary for their living. They were doing these in a spirit of hospitality and with whole heart. They gave what they needed to live. It is so with this widow that Jesus is observing. She gives two coins that she takes on her poverty and not on her superfluity. It's a striking gesture. And Jesus commented: "she gave everything, all she had to live", in other words, she gave what she is.

Like the widow, poor, weak and vulnerable, it is from our indigence that we have to give and not only from our wealth. To know what we need to give, let's not start with our wealth, but with our poverty, with what we already lack: Time; Attention; Love.... From there, we will experience the true solidarity and especially the blessing of the Lord that accompanies our generosity.
