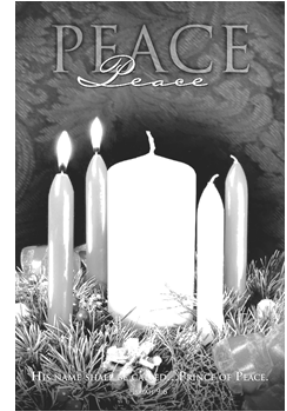


TRINITY NEWS
