WEEK 11. LENT 1. March 10, 2019

Church calls the period in which we entered on Ash Wednesday quadragesimal, which is a time of forty days and, through a clear reference to Holy Scripture, who introduces us into a precise spiritual context. Forty is indeed the symbolic number by which the Old and New Testaments represent the most important moments of the experience of the faith of Israel. It is a number that expresses the time of return to the Lord. This number does not represent an exact chronological time. It indicates rather a patient perseverance, a long ordeal.

Before beginning his public life, Jesus retired to the desert for forty days, without eating or drinking: he eats the Word of God, which he uses as a weapon to defeat the devil. The temptations of Jesus are reminiscent of those which the Jewish people faced in the desert, but which they did not know how to overcome. The "desert" is also the negative aspect of the reality that surrounds us: aridity, poverty of words of life and values, secularism ... In this "desert", we believers certainly have the opportunity to accomplish a deep experience of God that makes the spirit strong, in the awareness that from darkness the Lord will bring forth the new day. Happy Lent to all! "
